Harris County to conduct canvass of the November 8, 2011 Election

Houston, TX –The Harris County Judge has called a special meeting at the request of the County Clerk for the purpose of conducting the canvass of the November 8, 2011 State Constitutional Amendments and creation of Emergency Service District Number 75 Election. The meeting will be held on **Monday, November 21, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.**, in the Courtroom of the Commissioners Court of Harris County, Texas, on the ninth floor of the Harris County Administration Building, 1001 Preston Avenue, Houston, Texas.

“The final ballots have been counted, including the military and provisional ballots. For all intents and purposes, the election night results are final. However, the results are unofficial until each political subdivision which had items on the ballot canvass the vote. The City of Houston and the other political subdivisions on the ballot will separately canvass their votes,” said Stan Stanart who as Harris County Clerk is the Chief Election Officer of the county.

By law, each local canvassing authority must convene to conduct the local canvass at the time set by the canvassing authority's presiding officer not earlier than the eighth day or later than the 11th day after Election Day [Texas Election Code - Section 67.003].
